Pray for those serving in the military at home and abroad.



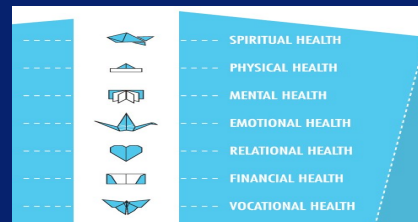
